October Day of Renewal

"Give what you have received!"

A little over 50 people showed up for this event, despite the overcast and rainy weather. The music was provided by Clint Bentz and his family. We began the morning with praise and worship, and many were moved by the depth and intensity of it. It was deeply refreshing and inspiring. After the praise and worship we had two talks before lunch.

Fr Odo Recker, a monk of Mt Angel Abbey, was our presenter. Fr Odo was involved in the renewal in Ohio and was a well known speaker. Fr Odo began by setting the scene by looking at the faith of the apostles and the religious environment they were coming from. Then in the second talk he focused on Jesus the Messiah and how he fulfilled all the prophecies, even though it was not the way people were expecting. Fr Odo then went on to highlight how Jesus was Messiah on the cross and how the cross is part of our lives. The important thing is to be faithful to what we are called to, as Jesus was. Fr Odo reminded us that while we like the cross, we often want it padded so that it doesn't hurt as much when we have to carry it. He also emphasized that the cross doesn't go away if we ignore it but it does change when we offer it!

After lunch we had another period of stirring praise and worship from Clint Bentz and his worship team. Thereafter Fr Odo concluded with his third talk, and what a powerful and hard hitting talk it was! He reminded us of the prophecy of Joel and how in the last days God's Spirit would be poured out. This began at Pentecost and continues through today and until the end of time. Fr Odo strongly emphasized that the key gift of the Catholic Charismatic renewal is the baptism in the Holy Spirit. Then he went on to tell us "Give what you have received!" And if we expect to bring others into the life in the Spirit then we need to live it and reflect it. In this vein Fr Odo reminded us that if we are not dead then we are not done with our own ongoing conversion. He concluded by exhorting us to obey the Lord as He is faithful to His promises. What happened at Pentecost is still happening and that we are caught up in it. And to be part of this we need to live it ourselves and to share with other what we have received!

2010 SCRC Conference

SCRC is Southern California Renewal Communities, the organization supporting the Catholic Charismatic Renewal in the region. Every year they have a conference which draws thousands of people. This year was no exception as over 7,000 people registered for the conference and many others came for single sessions or for a day. The conference is the largest of its kind in the USA at present. Approximately 45 speakers gave talks, did workshops, and ran seminars. The 2010 conference theme was "Stand Firm in the Faith"

There were various conference tracks including those for Teens, Young Adults, Children, and for Vietnamese. John Michael Talbot, the famous Catholic musician provided some of the music and a workshop. Other presenters included Fr Bill Adams CSSR who did a healing Mass here at St. Rose in Portland last July. Other speakers included Patti Mansfield who was present at the Duquesne weekend in 1967, Fr Stan Fortuna CFR, Sr Linda Koontz SNJM, and Fr Michael Barry SSCC who is also a frequent visitor to the northwest.

The absence of pain, and the ability to sleep through the night without pain is a wonderful gift from the Lord! Praise God!
