CHARISMATIC MASS AND HEALING PRAYER

On Friday August 5, Fr. Bill Adams CSSR presided at a Mass and led prayers for healing afterwards. The Mass was held at St. Rose parish in northeast Portland. The music was provided by Daniel Oberreuter and his wife, both of the group *Thirsting*. Approximately 90 people attended. Most of them came forward for prayer at the end of Mass.

Fr. Bill encouraged us to be open to the healing power of God. He also encouraged us to be open to whatever God has for us. He reminded us that often we come to the Lord with our own wants, needs, and desires and sometimes leave disappointed when these are not met. However, God knows what we need most and what is best for us at that moment and we might miss this if we

are not open to it. He encouraged us to present our needs to the Lord but also to ask God for whatever he might wish to give to us at that moment.



INSPIRATION

This is a prophecy from the August 5 Mass with Fr. Bill Adams.

The Kingdom of God consists not in spoken words but in Power!

The coming of the kingdom does not admit of observation, and there will be no one to say, "Look, it is here, look it is there!" for look the Kingdom of God is among you (*Luke 17: 20-21*). This is the answer Jesus gave to the Pharisees who had asked him when the Kingdom of God

would appear. This does not refer to a geographic place or location but to our hearts and minds for Christ. We are called to bring his kingdom everywhere we go.

At the beginning of this year our CIC group got together to evaluate our walk with the Lord. One of the brothers wondered why so many of us lack the power of the Holy Spirit in our lives and yet he dwells in us. Yes, each one of us who has been baptized in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit has the fullness of the third person of the Trinity in him or her. If he is in us why do we still live the life of sin that the Lord Jesus saved us from?

I received the gifts of the Holy Spirit when I was prayed over a few years ago and it was such a wonderful experience. Little did I know that was only the beginning and I needed to move on into the knowledge of the things of God. Despite having the gifts of the Holy Spirit, I was still living in fear, sometimes afraid to stand up for the truth. I was still sinning. The gifts alone could not change me. I needed to cooperate with the Holy Spirit to have a complete change of mind and heart. The gifts are for the building of the kingdom, not an end in themselves.

One of the main hindrances to fully experiencing the power of God in our lives is fear. Fear in all its forms is the strongest weapon the devil can use against us; fear to stand up for the truth, fear to believe and trust God, fear of man... the list goes on. In *Romans 8:15*, Paul says, For what you received was not the Spirit of slavery to bring you back into fear; you received the Spirit of adoption enabling us to cry out Abba, Father! Countless times in all the gospels, Jesus encourages all those who come to him not to be afraid. When we stand boldly in faith, believing in God, fear is destroyed and the power of God is unleashed in us.
